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VISITOR INFORMATION

Dear Visitor:

Welcome to Nuuciq Spirit Camp on Hinchinbrook Island. This island is owned and operated by Chugach Alaska Corporation and the Nuuciq Spirit Camp is managed by the Chugach Heritage Foundation. All visitors to the Nuuciq Spirit Camp are required to read the following information, rules, and sign the attached NSC Release of Liability.

Health and Safety Issues

There are various potential hazards on the Island "both man-made and natural" of which visitors should be mindful. Some examples of natural hazards are severe weather conditions, wild animals (bears), steep cliffs, rocky terrain, access to open water, and cold temperature of the water. Some of the man-made hazards are fuel storage areas, generator rooms, kitchen and other various machinery. Visitors are required to remain in designated areas and keep away from all areas marked as Restricted Areas. Travel to and from your location to Nuuciq Spirit Camp may include travel by vehicle, small plane and/or boat.

Non-Camp Participants

Nuuciq Spirit Camp activities may include: a tour of NSC facilities and grounds, potluck dinner with camp participants, and the opportunity to observe camp activities which may include dance, language and craft classes. Visitors are responsible for their children and those children under their guardianship and care at all times during their travel and visit to Nuuciq Spirit Camp. This includes monitoring children during transport, near the water, on NSC facilities and grounds, keeping children away from Restricted Areas and equipment and informing their children of the various risks and hazards on the Chugach Property as described herein and by Nuuciq Spirit Camp staff. For their safety and the safety of others, visitors of the Nuuciq Spirit Camp are expected to follow the instruction of Nuuciq Spirit Camp staff.

Medical Care

In the event of illness or injury, the nearest emergency medical facilities are in Cordova, about 30 minutes away by float plane. During Nuuciq Spirit Camp we will have Community Health Aides and a clinic that will be available for minor health issues. A patient with a serious illness or injury will be transported to the nearest medical facility for medical assistance. Sometimes other visitors with medical or alternative health care training may offer help or advice to adults; if this help is accepted by the adult visitor, then the visitor is acting entirely on their own initiative and not under the direction of the Nuuciq Facility staff, Nuuciq Spirit Camp staff, Chugach Heritage Foundation, or Chugach Alaska Corporation.

Other Guidelines

Visitors are not permitted to publish any photographs taken of the Nuuciq Spirit Camp participants, visitors, staff or Volunteers.

Nuuciq Spirit Camp is a drug and alcohol-free environment, with a zero-tolerance policy. Possession or use of drugs or alcohol of any kind is expressly forbidden. Smoking is permitted in designated areas only. Food is permitted in designated areas only.



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Staff at Nuuciq Spirit Camp is always available to answer any questions about NCS and its rules.

_____ The attached health history is true and accurate to the best of my knowledge, and that I or the minor listed below has permission and ability to engage in all the described camp activities.

_____ I understand that if I or the minor applicant have a contagious disease on the date of travel to Nuuciq Spirit Camp (NSC), I may be prohibited from traveling to or attending programs or activities at NSC. A contagious disease, as defined by Alaska Statute Sec. 18.15.395(3), is an infectious disease that can be transmitted from individual to individual. Examples of a contagious disease include but are not limited to a severe cold, flu, strep throat, mononucleosis, measles, mumps, and chicken pox. CHF staff will make this decision at their sole discretion for the safety and benefit of the youth, participants, volunteers, employees and fellow visitors.
